Visual Arts Camps play a vital role in introducing campers to a variety of art mediums, instructors are responsible for delivering safe, fun, and educational experiences for our campers. Instructors lead Visual Arts Camps for children ages 4-12 from July 2 - August 30, 2024.

Duties of the Visual Arts Camp Instructor will include, but are not limited to:

- Supervising campers while in the care of Confederation Centre of the Arts
- Delivering fun and engaging lessons in various mediums of Visual Arts including, but not limited to: painting, sculpture, collage, arts and crafts
- Teaching numerous classes to camp participants
- Coordinate and collaborate with other instructors
- Ensuring any Covid-19 protocols are upheld by campers
- On-going communications with parents, students, fellow teachers, and administrators
- Assist with program preparation and wind-up
- Studio organization
- other duties as required

The ideal candidate will have:

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills; English essential
- Positive attitude, patient, empathetic
- Detail oriented
- Ability to work independently with little or no supervision and prioritize efficiently
