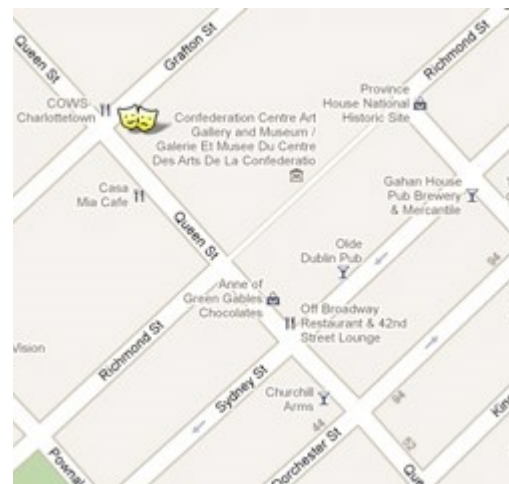


Confederation Centre of the Arts - Loading Information

The loading area is located at 145 Richmond St. in Charlottetown, by the stage door entrance. Richmond Street is a one-way street, accessible via Queen Street. During summer months the access is limited as a section of the street is pedestrianised and called “Victoria Row”. Access for loading in-out can be arranged with prior notice, preferably a minimum of 7 days.



The white truck shows where our loading bay is located.



Parking is limited and restricted to the left side of the street. However, with prior arrangement it can be arranged for loading in/out as well as longer term parking for audio/video mobile vehicles.

The loading bay is on a downward angle from the street. The loading bay doors can accommodate vehicles up to but no larger than **9'9" high x 9' wide x 26' long.**





You will need to ramp down from the vehicle and ramp up to load into our shop area which leads directly onto the main stage.

Door width is 8 feet

The ramp is 8 feet wide.

On a night load out, there is limited street lighting, so additional lighting may be required for complicated loads.
