Camp Withdrawal

Students can withdrawal two-weeks prior to the start of camp week. Students who must withdraw after this time-period must provide a medical note to receive a refund.

Exceptions for medical or compassionate reasons will be considered when notified by email to artseducation@confederationcentre.com.

Camp Cancellations

If camps are cancelled by Confederation Centre, a full or partial refund will be granted.

Camp Missed Classes

No refunds or make-ups will be granted for camps missed by the student for reasons including, but not limited to, illness, scheduling conflicts and/or vacation.

Age Policy

Our summer camps are designed for students at specific developmental stages based on each age group. Campers must be the required minimum age by the time camp begins to register. This is in fairness to others, as well as for the comfort and safety of all participants. We set our age ranges with care, and value both age-appropriate instruction and environments. Especially at younger ages, children tend to change developmentally over short time periods.

Exploring Performing Arts and Exploring Visual Arts

6 - 12 years: Child must turn 6 or still be 12 by the Friday before the start of camp

- Note: In performing arts, campers will be divided into two groups by age on the first day of camp.

Intermediate Dance

10-13 years: Child must turn 10 or still be 13 by the Friday before the start of camp.

Dancer must have at least 3 years of dance experience and understand basic dance terminology.

Kinder Performing and Visual Arts

4 - 5 years: Child must turn 4 or still be 5 by the Friday before the start of camp

Senior Dance

13-18 years: Child must turn 13 or still be 18 by the Friday before the start of camp.

Dancer must have at least 5 years of dance experience.

Musical Theatre Intensive

12 – 18 years: Child must turn 12 or still be 18 by the Friday before the start of camp.

Youth Choir Camp

8-18 years: Child must turn 8 or still be 18 by the Friday before the start of camp.

Loop de Loop Teen Animation

13-17 years: Child must turn 13 or still be 17 by the Friday before the start of camp.

Behavior Policy

We strive to ensure every camper feels welcome and supported in all our programming. To promote consistent behavior expectations, we follow the “FISH” policy.

F = Follow instructions

I = Include everyone

S = Show respect

H = Help each other

If any child has difficulty meeting our behavior expectations, we will follow our three steps of check-in.

1. **Check-in:** conversation between camper and instructor. Student and instructor have a conversation reviewing rules and safety policies, identify the cause of problem or incident, and work together to problem-solve a strategy or alternative resolution.
2. **Conversation with guardian/family:** If action persists after check-ins between instructor and camper, staff will arrange a conversation with guardian/family regarding concerns and strategize or problem-solve an alternative resolution together. It will be communicated that if the action continues to be a concern, the camper will be asked to leave the next time it occurs.
3. **Camp Dismissal:** Camper may be dismissed if their behavior continues to prevent safe and effective participation in our programs. Dismissal may occur after conversation between guardian/family, camper and program staff.

Note: *Confederation Centre has the discretion to dismiss a student immediately under appropriate circumstances.*



Support Needs and Health Concerns

We are committed to making our programming accessible to all. To allow us to make appropriate accommodations, please inform Arts Education staff prior to the start of your child(ren)’s camp of any health concerns, including allergies and support needs. We will work with you to identify the necessary resources for your child. In some circumstances, due to staffing and physical space, limitations may impact our ability to accommodate specific needs.
