

Registration & Payment Information

We are excited to share that we are upgrading our studio software to a different service provider called **Studio Pro!** We are implementing this change to provide you with enhanced, easy-to-use features. This will make it convenient for you to register for classes, view schedules, make payments, receive updates, and much more!

Our full dance season runs from September to May.

Students must be registered for autopay to register for the full season.

50% of tuition is collected upon registration online.

The remaining 50% will be charged on **January 13th, 2027.**

Deadline to register for the season – September 26th, 2026

Deadline to register for Musical Theatre Program – September 26th, 2026

Mid season registrations are possible.

Deadline to register – January 30th, 2027

Six-week classes must be paid in full prior to the first class.

METHODS OF PAYMENT

- Visa, Mastercard, or American Express (Online Only)
- No box office payments accepted.

Students will not be allowed to participate/continue classes unless payments are up to date.

COSTUME FEES

All costume fees will be automatically applied at checkout through Studio Pro (varies per class). The single \$50 flat fee per dancer is being replaced with a per-class fee that **ranges from \$25 to \$50, including HST**, set based on costume requirements. Some classes carry no costume fee at all.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The Confederation Centre of the Arts offers limited financial assistance for students in all its Arts Academy programs and camps. Applications are confidential, and we encourage anyone for whom cost is a barrier to reach out. **Applications must be received no later than two weeks before the start of classes.**

TRIAL CLASSES

We encourage all our students to try a variety of dance styles, and we are more than happy to accommodate! **Trial classes are \$25 per class for up to 2 classes max.** If you decide to continue with the class, you must return to your account to register for the full season.

REFUNDS

We offer a partial refund if you choose to withdraw by **October 16, 2026**. You'll be refunded the amount paid minus **\$25.00 per class attended**.

New students joining the winter semester are eligible for a refund **no more than two weeks after registration**.

DISCOUNTS & HST

Multiclass discounts apply to students or members of the same household taking three or more classes per week. This is automatically applied at checkout through Studio Pro. The discount applies to weekly-class fees only.

6-week series and Performance Group are billed at face value and excluded from the discount.

A twice-weekly class (Intermediate Ballet, Senior Ballet, I.T.P. Ballet) counts as one class toward the discount threshold.

HST is applicable to all adult class registrations.

The table below is an example of how discounts work in the system. Our current class prices vary based on level/age/requirements.

Weekly classes	Discount on weekly fees	Example total (\$440 classes)
1 class	Full price	\$440
2 classes	Full price	\$880
3 classes	10% off	\$1,188
4 classes	15% off	\$1,496
5 classes	20% off	\$1,760
6+ classes	25% off	\$1,980
